

To launch files automatically from a Folder or Downloaded Audio file, the default Program must be set to auto launch the Start Stop Software. This guide is a general walkthrough to set defaults for specific audio type files. In this example we will use a MP3 type audio file:

1. Select the "Start" Button




2. Select "Default Programs"




3. Select "Associate a File type or Protocol with a program."




4. Scroll Down to filetype: MP3 is highlighted and the Program that is currently Default is Windows Media Player (Under "Current Default"). To Change the default player and with filetype **Highlighted**, click on "Change Program" (Blue Arrow).




5. Start Stop Software may or may not be listed in "Open With..." window. If it is listed, select Start Stop Software. If not...Select "Browse" (Green Arrow).

6. You will need to navigate to the Start Stop Software Folder. With the "Open with..." window, click on Local Drive (Most Likely 'C:') → Program Files (x86) or Program Files → HTH Engineering → Start Stop Software folder.



7. Select 'StartStopV12.exe' (may also be StartStopV9.exe in older versions) application and click on Open. Click OK on next window to select Start Stop as Default.

8. The Default Program will have changed.

All MP3 type files will now open, by default, with the Start Stop Software.
